he Berkley CruiseFest kicks off the first of the TEN DAYS OF PACKARD, (August 17-26, 2018) encouraging members to be seen driving their Packards. Members have 3 ways to participate:

1. Drive your car in the Berkley CruiseFest (5:00 pm)

Parade participants are invited to stage their cars in the Roseland Park Cemetery on the corner of 12 Mile and Woodward with gates opening at 5:00 P.M. on Friday, August 17, the day prior to the Woodward Dream Cruise.

From 5:00 pm until 6:15 pm, the cemetery is a CAR SHOW for the participants to relax, picnic, and enjoy the cars and meet up with other MCP members. Gates close at 6:00. At 6:15, the staff calls: "Drivers, start your engines!" Cars start their journey along 12 Mile Rd. from Woodward to Greenfield. Several photographers, videographers and news channels will be stationed outside the gate on 12 MILE to film cars as they slowly drive past. All intersections along 12 Mile are closed. The pace is slow enough to chat with many fans along the route. The course is safe and well monitored.

To participate, you may either register online at Berkley.maxgalaxy.net or complete the enclosed yellow registration, send it with a \$10 check payable to City of Berkley by May 30th to insure space for your vehicle. Registration is limited to 400 cars. Cars range from early Model T's to 1970's.

2. Just watch the 400-car parade (6:00 pm)

Starting after 6:00, bring a lawn chair to the Dairy Queen at 12 Mile and Royal (3491 12 Mile Rd.)

3. After the parade (7:30-ish).

Meet other club members at L George's Coney Island, 26799 Greenfield Rd., Southfield 48076 (Southwest of the 11 Mile and Greenfield intersection).
